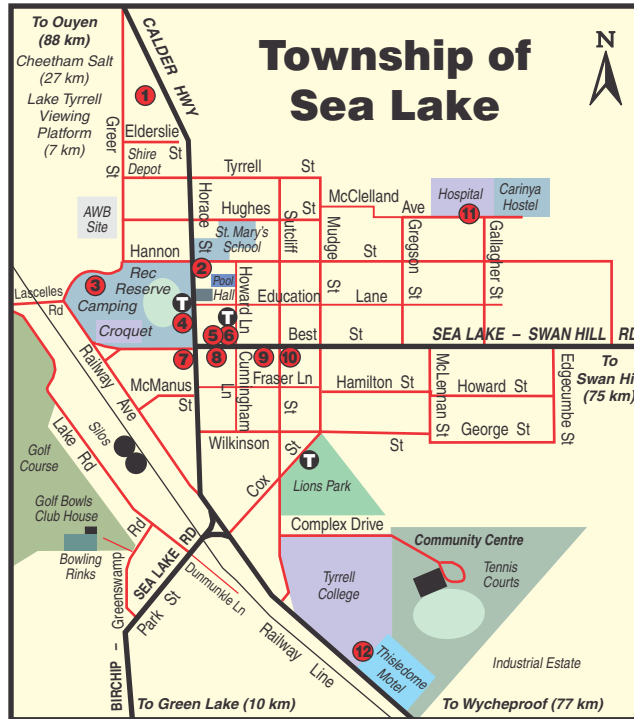

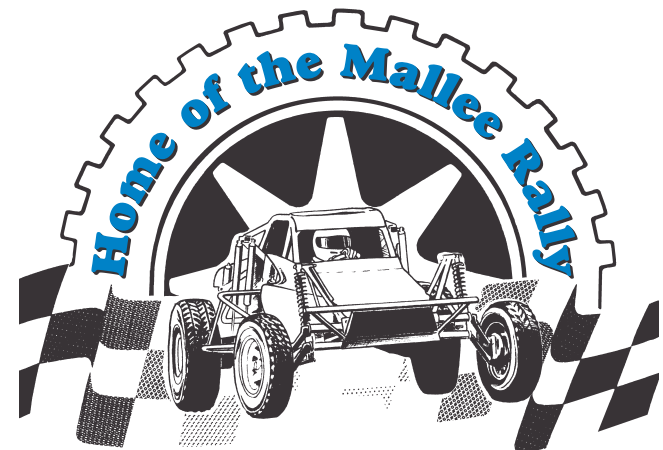

### Lake Tyrrell

The Sea Lake Off Road Club organises scenic tours of the famous Lake Tyrrell Off Road track every second year.



**LAKE TYRRELL:** See the striking pink hues of this unique salt lake. The lake environment is host to Mallee reptiles, kangaroos, emus, white faced chats, Aboriginal archaeological sites, large lunettes and an inland gully. A viewing platform is located 7 kms north of Sea Lake. Over 200,000 tonnes of salt is extracted yearly from the lake. Stay 'til night time and see spectacular stars reflected on the water. The lake was once the pride of the Boorong people who could see the possum Bunya at the top of the Southern Cross and the age old presence of the giant emu Tchingal in the dark space of the Milky Way.
