Wycheproof (pop. 800) is located on the Calder Hwy midway between Melbourne and Mildura, at the gateway to the Murray, Mallee and Sunset Country.

The word Wycheproof means reed growing on a hill.

Wycheproof is home to the smallest registered mountain in the world, Mt. Wycheproof (43m).

Wycheproof is the centre of a rich grain growing area with a major central receiving silo complex for wheat and other grains.

COMMUNITY

The town boasts a top ranking P-12 College and excellent medical, hospital & aged care facilities. There is a range of active sports clubs.

Wycheproof VISION Inc. brings together volunteer groups—business, environmental and social—to work to promote our town to the wider community.

The distinctive Art Deco hall and offices at Wycheproof is the administration centre for Buloke Shire Council.



HISTORY

The first inhabitants of the area was the Bulla Bulla Wycher clan.

The first recorded European settlement was in 1846 when Robert Macredie established Wycheproof Station. Early settlers included the Dempsey, Dobbin, Ryan and O'Connor families.

Wycheproof is known for the railway line in the main street Broadway, opened in 1883.

Wycheproof Historical Society, established 1982, has a repository for documents and photographic collection housed at the Wycheproof Court House. Wander though history at Willandra Museum.

Take a break from your trip. Enjoy a leisurely picnic or barbecue under shade trees in Centenary Park .

A walk along Broadway reveals a range of businesses including bakery, coffee shop, cafe, grocery, gift shops, pharmacy, hardware, newsagency, art and crafts, Op Shop, Mens Shed, electrical & homewares, internet, book exchange and classes at the Wycheproof Community Resource Centre, banks, ATM, sculpture Gallery, hotels and motel.

As you stroll down Broadway, take a moment to sit in the sun and enjoy a yarn with friendly local identities.



March The hottest weekend in lawn tennis is the Wycheproof Tennis Tournament on the Labour Day weekend.

The Wycheproof Great Grain Festival. Feature event is Music On the Mount—bringing together local and international talent in an outdoor concert on the slopes of Mt Wycheproof.
